

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Please deliver all exhibits to the Spearwood Dalmatinac Club on Friday 4th October between 9.30am - 11am.
2. All entries must remain on display until close of the exhibition 4.30pm Sunday 6th October .
3. Paintings must be suitably presented. Photography & Digital Imaging mounted, all work to be suitable for hanging. Size not to exceed 1m x 1m including frame.
4. While care is taken with the entries during the exhibition, insurance issues will be the responsibility of the individual exhibitor.
5. Judges decisions are final and binding. They reserve the right not to award a prize in any category if standards are not met. Certificates of merit may be awarded at their discretion.
6. Sale price of work should include a 20% commission inclusive of GST which will be levied on all sales. All artists are required to complete the declaration on the Entry Form regarding GST & ABN Numbers.
7. Entries are to be the original work of the artist and completed within the last 12 months.
8. Entries are limited to 3 (three) per artist in each category or section.
9. No late entries or substitutes will be accepted.
10. Committee may refuse items if deemed not suitable or not conforming with conditions.
11. "Aspects of Cockburn" **must be for sale** and executed in oils, acrylics, watercolour, inks, pencil, pastels etc. The City of Cockburn provides \$1.000 to purchase artworks, conditional on suitable works being entered and may select works for its own collection.
